Two stretcher units is arranged for ICU patients on ventilator. The Third stretcher is for a stable patient.

Stretcher One - ICU as standard

- 1 Hamilton respirator
- 2 infusion pumps (more if needed)
- 1 Propag MD multimonitor or Schiller Life Care Monitor (all Works as AED)
- 1 Suction Units to Life port Units and one portable Unit for ground transport.
- 2 Oxygen flow meters
- 1 Disinfectent solution

Stretcher two - ICU as standard

- 1 LTV 1200 respirator.
- 2 infusion pumps (more if needed)
- 1 Propag MD multimonitor or Schiller Life Care Monitor (all Works as AED)
- 1 Suction Units to Life port Units and one portable Unit for ground transport.
- 2 Oxygen flow meters
- 1 Disinfectent solution

Stretcher three - standard

1 Propag LT (EKG, NIBP, SAO2)

1 Oxygen flow meters

Standard Equipment in reach for use for all patients

One bag for each ventilator and monitor with all needed accessories

for handling ground transports and multiple transports.

2 portable oxygen cylinders for ground transport.

Mcgrath videolaryngoskope in a special unit with accessories for difficult intubation.

2 bags for ground transport, including accessories for intubation and intravenous management.

1 bag with a wide range of intravenious fluids for ICU patients.

1 bag with equipment for different sterile procedures ex Ambulatory Chest Drainage Kit.

IZ-EO Intraosseous Vascular Access System.

All needed medication in 3 bags - standard sortiment for performing multiple transports.

All equipment needed for care and nursing.

Needed equipment for World Wide Access to Power and Oxygen supply.

One IPAD and One Iphone With access to our rutines and standards.
